ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

GENERAL REFERENCES

Peace and good order — See Ch. 121.

§ 44-1. Drinking in public.

Section 4.1-308 of the Code of Virginia, regarding drinking in public, is hereby adopted by reference thereto by the Town Council.

§ 44-2. Violations and penalties. [Amended 7-8-1996]

Any person who violates any provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a Class 4 misdemeanor, with penalties as provided in § 1-7, General penalty, of Chapter 1, General Provisions.

§ 44-3. Construal of provisions.

This chapter shall not prevent any person from drinking alcoholic beverages or offering a drink thereof to another in the dining room or other designated room, as defined in §§ 4.1-206, 4.1-207 and 4.1-208, Code of Virginia 1950, as amended, of a hotel, restaurant, club or boat or in any dining car, club car or buffet car of any train or in any other establishment, provided that such hotel, restaurant, club, boat, dining car, club car, buffet car or establishment or the person who operates the same is licensed to sell at retail for consumption in such dining room, room, car or establishment such alcoholic beverages, and the alcoholic beverages drunk or offered were purchased therein.
