§ 119-1. Sale of goods or services on Town property.

- A. No person shall offer for sale any goods or services on any property owned by the Town during any special event, function, or festivity on such property without the permission of the Town.
- B. This section shall apply notwithstanding whether the person offering for sale goods or services on Town property has secured a peddlers' permit under § 144-30 of this Code.
- C. A person may obtain permission from the Town under this section by applying to the Town Council or Mayor for such permission. If they deem it to be in the best interests of the Town, the Town Council or Mayor may place conditions or restrictions on the permission.
- D. Any person whom the Town invites to offer goods or services for sale on Town property shall be deemed to have permission to offer goods or services for sale under this section, without any further action by the Town or by such person.
- E. The Chief of Police may revoke permission under this section if he believes that the holder thereof has violated the terms or conditions of the permission.
- F. Any person who offers to sell goods or services in violation of Town Code § 119-1A shall be guilty of a Class 4 misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for each offense. Each offer to sell goods or services shall constitute a separate offense for the purposes of this section.
- G. This section shall not apply to any offer to sell goods or services that is made by an organization then leasing property from the Town, when such offer is made on the property that the organization leases from the Town.
- H. This section shall not apply to any offer to sell goods or services that takes place on Town property that:
 - (1) Adjoins property owned by the person making the offer; and

- (2) Is not paved; and
- (3) Is held by the Town primarily for future use as a street right-of-way.
