

Town Manager's Memo

I hope everyone's summer is off to a good start – it's certainly been hot, but it's summer in Virginia so it goes with the territory at times.

The Town has wrapped up the very important Sixth Street water line project and will be continuing down Dogwood to Third Street this summer with a new water line that will be fed off the new line on 6th Street. These improvements will add durability and increased water volumes in the Town's system.

Now that the 6th Street line is complete, paving is scheduled soon to get the street cleaned up and looking good. In addition to

6th Street, the following streets are also slated to be paved this summer:

Berkeley Ave. from the south side of A Street to the dead end.

Birch Ave. from the south side of 6th Street to the north side of 3rd Street.

4th Street from the east side of Dogwood Ave. to the west side of Birch Ave.

8th Street from the east side of Birch Ave. to the dead end.

18th Street from east of Dogwood Ave. to the dead end.

All road cuts from the water main breaks that occurred over winter.



There are many events happening around Town this summer that are always posted on the calendar on the Town's website, whether it's bluegrass, baseball, festivals or just hanging out at the pool, there is a lot happening in town.


